

He is having a phototoxic reaction to the tetracycline. Consider stopping the drug until the trip is over. Cold compresses may help relieve any pain. You'll need to make sure he wears protective clothing and uses a zinc oxide based sun block on all exposed skin for the remainder of the trip. Given the short length of the trip, his signs and symptoms may or may not resolve while in the mountains. Consider staying in camp under shade during the peak sun hours (10 am to 4 pm).
