

Rosa fractured her left clavicle, has a mild concussion, and a possible spine <u>and</u> spinal cord injury. The failed motor exams in her right hand and the tingling in her right arm indicate a possible spinal cord injury (and by default a possible spine injury); the pain from her broken clavicle may be masking any spine pain or tenderness she may have. Remember that voluntary movement in her normal range of motion will not exacerbate a potential spine or cord injury. That said, handle her extremely gently and protect her spinal cord during her evacuation. While she does not have any additional critical system problems—moderate concussion/increased ICP, respiratory distress, or internal bleeding—attempt to get her to a hospital for further evaluation within 24 hours.
